

UNINSURED LOSSES

POLICY NUMBER: 203
DATE ADOPTED: October 22, 1996
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Colusa County has determined that there are occasions when existing insurance coverage, whether self-insured or purchased policies, do not cover all possible exposures that the county has in its day-to-day operation and, therefore, adopts the following policy for the distribution of losses and costs for those uninsured exposures.

- I. After a finding by CSAC-Excess Insurance Authority that there is no coverage, the Board of Supervisors shall determine the responsible departments to be charged and shall direct the county Auditor/Risk Manager to allocate costs to the chargeable department(s).
- II. If there is a joint accountability between two or more departments, the Board of Supervisors shall determine the percentage for each department and the Auditor shall be directed to allocate the costs based on the board determined percentages.
