Prenatal Care

Moms should start prenatal care during the first trimester (1-12 Weeks)

Prenatal Care:

- Special medical care while you are pregnant.
- Most moms get at least 10 visits
- Your doctor/midwife will monitor the baby and check on your health.

Benefits of Prenatal Care in the first trimester:

- More likely to deliver a full-term baby at a healthy baby weight.
- Can protect you and your baby from medical complication during pregnancy and birth.
