RULE 500

1 **SOURCE FEES:** The fees contained in Rule 500 shall apply to all sources of air pollution emissions subject to the Air Pollution Control District's Rules.

2 APPLICATION FOR AUTHORIZATION TO CONSTRUCT, PERMIT TO OPERATE AND NOTIFICATION OF OPERATION:.

- 2.1 An application and evaluation fee will be charged for all sources that apply for an Authorization to Construct and Permit to Operate. The fee will cover the review of the project emissions, air quality impacts and the preparation of an air quality summary analysis report. The application filing fee will be \$228.00, plus the actual Air Pollution Control District's cost of the evaluation at \$65.00 per hour.
- 2.2 The fee for a Notification of Operation shall be \$85.00, plus the actual Air Pollution Control District's cost of evaluation at \$65.00 per hour.
- 2.3 The above permits shall be assessed a fee to include the costs imposed by the Sacramento Valley Basinwide Air Pollution Control Council of up to \$5.00 per permit.

3 ANNUAL PERMIT TO OPERATE RENEWAL FEES:

3.1 An annual fee shall be charged for renewal of all sources with a Permit to Operate. The annual renewal fee shall be determined as follows by the aggregate of the criteria pollutants:

Annual renewal fee of \$110.00 plus the following:

Sources up to 1 ton per year	\$ 237.50
Sources 1 to 5 tons per year	\$ 279.00
Sources 5 to 10 tons per year	\$ 380.00
Sources 10 to 15 tons per year	\$ 465.00
Sources 15 to 20 tons per year	\$ 549.00
Sources 20 to 25 tons per year	\$ 634.00
Sources 25 tons per year and over	\$ 744.00 plus \$39.00

	ton over 25

- **3.2** The above annual permit renewal fee includes a \$5.00 fee per permit which covers costs imposed by the Sacramento Valley Basinwide Air Pollution Control Council.
- **3.3** The provisions of this Rule shall become effective October 1, 1999.
- **4 ANNUAL INSPECTION FEES:** An annual inspection fee may be charged to conduct the annual inspection of major sources in the DISTRICT. Major sources

shall include all firms with actual emissions equal to or greater than ten (10) tons per year of any pollutant for which there is a state or federal ambient air quality standard. The fee will be based on the actual Air Pollution Control District's cost of the inspection at \$65.00 per hour.

5 TRANSFER FEES:

- **5.1** Where an Authorization to Construct, a Notification of Operation or a Permit to Operate is transferred from one person to another, and where no modification of the source has been made, the person in possession of the Authorization to Construct, Notification of Operation or Permit to Operate shall pay a \$85.00 transfer fee.
- **5.2** If the Air Pollution Control District is not notified within 30 days of the date of the transfer, the Authorization to Construct, a Notification of Operation or a Permit to Operate may be cancelled by the Air Pollution Control District.
