RULE 203

1 EXEMPTIONS TO RULE 200

- 1.1 In accordance with Section 41705 of the California Health and Safety Code, the provisions of Rule 200 do not apply to:
 - **1.1.1** Odors, emanating from agricultural operations necessary for the growing of crops or the raising of fowl, animals or bees.

2 EXEMPTIONS TO RULE 201 AND 202

- 2.1 In accordance with Section 41704 of the California Health and Safety Code, nothing in Rule 201 shall be construed to prohibit:
 - **2.1.1** Open burning as authorized in Rule 300 Section 1.3.1 of this Regulation;
 - **2.1.2** The use of orchard and citrus grove heaters which are in compliance with Rule 209;
 - **2.1.3** Emissions resulting from food preparation, heating or comfort fires in single or two-family dwellings, providing prohibited materials as outlined in Rule 300 Section 1.2.3 of this Regulation, are not burned.
