September 14, 2023 – November 8, 2023 is the Petition-In-Lieu of filing fee period. During this period, individuals interested in running for a Voter-Nominated or Nonpartisan office listed above may use the In-Lieu process of obtaining registered voters' signatures on the petition in order to reduce or eliminate the filing fee. Petition-In-Lieu filing fee forms may be obtained from the Colusa County Clerk-Recorder Registrar of Voters (Elections Office) located at 546 Jay Street, Suite 200. Office hours are Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. with extended hours on deadline dates. You may email candidates@countyofcolusa.com.

Candidates for Superior Court Judge, must file a declaration of intention between October 30, 2023 through November 8, 2023. Judicial candidates nonrefundable filing fees are due at the time of filing their declaration of intention, and, as such, no additional signature in-lieu of filing fee petitions may be accepted after the filing of their declaration of intention.

The Republican Central Committee filing period opens on September 29, 2023 through December 8, 2023. During this time candidates for Member of the Republican County Central Committee must file their declarations of candidacy for office, their ballot designation worksheets and circulate their nomination papers and deliver them to the Elections Official for filing.
