Colusa County Hosts Community Meeting on Sites Reservoir Project and Maxwell Community Plans

Residents Encouraged to Participate and Provide Input and Feedback

(COLUSA, CA) June 10, 2024 – Earlier today, the Colusa County Community Development Department (CDD) announced hosting a community meeting in Maxwell to listen to community concerns and gather community input ahead of the preparation of Community Plans for Maxwell and the areas surrounding the Sites Reservoir project. The meeting is scheduled for 6:00pm on Thursday, June 20th at the American Legion Building in Maxwell.

"We are very interested in hearing directly from the community, and invite Maxwell residents to join us for this important meeting," said Greg Plucker, Colusa County CDD Director. "It is our goal to develop a Community Plan for Maxwell that best meets the needs of the area's residents and businesses."

A Community Plan is a public document that contains specific proposals for future land uses and public improvements in a given community. The Maxwell Community Plan is expected to address key topics such as temporary workforce housing, long-term economic strategies, access to recreational areas, habitat conservation, transportation and traffic, and other potential changes to the Maxwell and Sites Reservoir areas.
