WHAT WE DO

INTAKES AND ASSESSMENTS

A Licensed Marriage Family Therapist, Certified Substance Use Disorders Counselor, or Psychiatrist will schedule an intake with the individual. These intakes are done weekly.

CASE MANAGEMENT AND MORE

Case management including transportation is offered daily. Individual counseling is offered as needed. Residential and Sober Living are offered out of county for clients needing this service.

PERINATAL SERVICES

If you are pregnant or a parenting mother and in need of support we provide a priority access for treatment and a variety of perinatal services.
