

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT at a regular meeting of the Colusa County Board of Supervisors on **March 25, 2025, at 9:30 a.m.** in the Board Chambers located at 546 Jay Street, Suite 108, Colusa, CA, the Board approved passage of Ordinance 844 as follows:

ORDINANCE SUMMARY

The County of Colusa adopted Ordinance 844 to grant an electrical line franchise to Janus Solar PV, LLC. The Franchise Ordinance grants Janus Solar PV, LLC. the right to place electric transmission lines, cables, conduit, connections, fittings and other related appurtenances and facilities necessary or convenient for the operation of said system of electric lines within the Public Right-of-Way of certain areas of unincorporated Colusa County. The Ordinance requires Janus Solar PV, LLC to pay a “Right-of-Way Occupancy Fee” of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) per linear foot of Transmission Lines installed within the Public Right-of-Way, which amount will be adjusted annually.
