



Colusa Home Visiting Program Referral Triage

Colusa County Home Visiting Program will implement the Referral Triage Plan when applications for the program are greater than our ability to support. This plan will determine priority of need in order to enable the home visiting program to provide our services to families with the greatest need. Need is to be assessed by points assessed by qualifiers. Qualifiers include parent age, employment status, education, insurance, marital status, income, age of youngest child, usage of services, and if the family has been referred to us by CPS.

Cases are triaged by use of a total point score based on qualifiers for need of the program.
Higher scores signify greater need.
