Wintun Nation ("Nation"); and

WHEREAS: on July 20, 1907, the Nation acquired an additional 480 acres by Order of the

Secretary of the Interior; and

WHEREAS: the Kletsel Dehe Wintun Nation is a sovereign Tribal Nation, recognized by the

Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs, possessing inherent powers of tribal self-government and self-determination, and operating pursuant to the Constitution and Bylaws of the Nation ("Governing Law"), as amended and adopted by the citizens of the Nation on December 15, 2018 pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (ch. 576, 48 Stat.

984, as amended); and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Article VI, Section 2(a) of the Governing Law, the Nation's

governing body is its elected Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS: pursuant to Article IX, Section 1(e) to administer all lands and assets and

manage all economic affairs and enterprises on unassigned lands of the

Nation.; and

WHEREAS: the Kletsel Dehe Wintun Nation participated in the regional planning process

for the 2024 Colusa County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan ("LHMP"), including the development of a dedicated annex addressing the unique vulnerabilities, risks, and mitigation strategies of the Nation for informational and planning
