## **REPORTING WELL PROBLEMS**

In an effort to assess drought impacts and general groundwater conditions, the Colusa County Water Resources Department (Department of Agriculture) is compiling information on well problems countywide. This information will help in our ongoing efforts to gain a better understanding of the local groundwater system. We are gathering information on **all well types** (domestic, irrigation, other) **and all well issues**, whether drought-related or mechanical. If you are experiencing problems with your water well, please take a few minutes to fill out the "Report of Well Problems" form which can be found on the County of Colusa website at <a href="http://countyofcolusa.org">http://countyofcolusa.org</a>. This reporting is voluntary and specific well locations will not be made public.

If you are a private homeowner with a domestic well that has lost water due to drought, you may be eligible to participate in a Household Water Tank Program. For more information on this program, contact the Colusa County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Services at 530-458-0218.
