IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS OF MEASURE A BY THE COLUSA COUNTY COUNSEL

This measure, if approved by a majority of qualified voters within the Cortina Community Services District, will cause a Board of Directors to be independently elected to govern and administer the District, separate and apart from the County of Colusa.

The Cortina Community Services District has been administered by the County of Colusa since the District's inception in 2006. District services are performed by County staff or provided through contracted entities. The Board of Supervisors for the County of Colusa serves as the Board of Directors and governing body for the District. On November 1, 2016, the Board of Supervisors caused this measure to be placed on the ballot as required by California Government Code section 61022(b)(2).

A "YES" vote on this measure will cause a 5 member Board of Directors to be independently elected to govern and administer the Cortina Community Services District, separate and apart from the County of Colusa. The elected Board members will serve staggered terms and elections will be held every 2 years for directors with expiring terms. The Cortina Community Services District will become an independent, self-administered, special district, governed by its elected Board.

A "NO" vote on this measure will result in no change to the governing body and administration of the Cortina Community Services District. The District will continue to be administered by the County of Colusa. The County Board of Supervisors will continue to serve as the Board of Directors for the Cortina Community Services District.
