Impartial Analysis by Local Agency Formation Commission of Measure to Form Maxwell Recreation & Park District

Heretofore, the Swimming Pool and other Recreation Services in the Maxwell area have been provided through the Maxwell Unified School District.

The Board of Supervisors has called this Election to form a separate entity for this purpose, under the Recreation and Park Districts Law, Chapter 4 (commencing at Section 5780) of Division 5 of the Public Resources Code, to be called the Maxwell Recreation & Park District. The boundaries of the District are to be the same as and coterminous with the boundaries of the Maxwell Election Precinct.

If formation of the District is approved, there will be established for said District an annual Special Assessment Of \$15.00 per residence upon any Assessor's parcel; and where there is no residence upon any Assessor's parcel, then the sum of \$3.00 per parcel or \$.07¢ per acre upon said parcel which ever is greater. The initial annual revenue is estimated at \$18,000.

A "Yes" vote on the Measure is a vote to form the District, and to establish the annual Special Tax Rate.

A "No" vote on the Measure is a vote to deny formation of the District, and to deny establishment of the annual Special Tax Rate.
